PLC-Transportation has completed a part of the Elizabeth River Tunnels rehabilitation. Portsmouth and Norfolk Virginia are home to the Navy fleet with many tunnels going underneath its rivers and passage through Chesapeake Bay to the Atlantic. The existing High Pressure Sodium lighting was replaced with LED fixtures.

PLC-Transportation's T51 controller is used along with our new TLUM-2 luminance sensor to provide switching control for the lighting. A SCADA interface allows for remote configuration, monitoring and control of the tunnel lighting control system. PLC's T51 controller allows for multiple levels of additive lighting in the tunnel, each individually configured with its own setpoints and timing settings.
